



Hurricane Valley *Sons of Utah Pioneers* **Scholarship**



Dear High School Senior (or Junior graduating early):

We invite you to apply for our annual Hurricane Valley Sons of the Utah Pioneers Scholarship. The amount of the award will depend on donations received by our chapter; up to \$1000. Applicants will be judged on the following criteria:

Cover Page: Include a picture of yourself. List your first and last name, mailing address, telephone number, and e-mail address above your picture. Title your essay under your picture. The name and your relationship to the ancestor you write about should be part of the title or shown just below it. List honors, accomplishments and leadership experiences you've had since completing 7th Grade in the lower portion of the page.

Direct Ancestor Essay: Read/learn about one of your ancestors and write an essay highlighting examples of faith, courage, endurance, character, deeds and/or accomplishments in that person's life. **Explain how learning more about this ancestor influences your philosophy and your choices in life.** Pay attention to spelling, grammar, punctuation, contextual flow, and so on. Your essay should be double-spaced, 12-point font, and two to four or five pages in length. Use legitimate sources but do not copy word-for-word unless quoting.

Letter of Recommendation: Provided by a teacher, school administrator, counselor or a religious leader familiar with your school habits. No relatives please. It should give us an accurate picture of your attitudes, work ethic, character, deeds and financial need.

Official High School Transcript: obtained through the Counseling Center.
