Dear Employees,

While the State Legislature set an upcoming deadline on the State Mask Mandate, please remember that this does not include schools in Utah. All employees, students and visitors will still be required to wear masks on school property, on a school bus and in school buildings. On March 10, Governor Cox issued the following announcement:

“...It’s important to note that the mask mandate will continue after April 10 in schools and for large gatherings. Also, businesses can still require masks. And of course, every individual can choose to wear a mask...”
