

Addie Savage Naegle & Barbara Hirschi Kleinman Memorial Scholarship Hurricane High School

Purpose: This scholarship is designed to assist deserving students that have a real desire to further their education at the college level & their GPA does not allow them to successfully acquire full tuition scholarships.

Eligibility: Open to graduating seniors attending Hurricane High School that display a commitment to further academic schooling & are reasonably judged to be successful in this endeavor. The recipient will be selected without regard to race, religion, or cultural background.

Criteria for Selection

Character of Candidate: Must be judged of high character as demonstrated by the qualities of selfless service, honesty, integrity & morality.

Financial Need: The preferred candidate is one who has a true personal and family financial need in order to further his/her education. If a candidate is outstanding in other areas, and lacking any other reasonable candidate, economic status may be disregarded. Determining economic status is solely the discretion of the Hurricane High School counseling department.

Academics: The candidate should have demonstrated a strong desire to do well in school which will successfully transfer to higher academic education; but which has not always resulted in a high letter grade. Excellence in academics is not a requirement but a GPA between 2.5 to 3.0 will be given priority consideration.

This scholarship will award 3 students a \$1,000 cash award.

Once the selection is made, the recipients will receive a letter of congratulations from the Washington County School District Foundation with all instruction to access the funds. That letter or copy of the letter should be presented to the institution of higher education at the time of registration. At that point, the college or university will request the funds from the Foundation. Once the request has been made, a check will be sent to the college or university in behalf of the student. This award is to be used for tuition, fees, or books only. The administration of the funds is at the sole discretion of the higher institution.

Scholarship funds must be used within two years of receiving the award, unless notification of an extension is given in advance to the committee treasure. If funds are not used within 2 years the money will be reassigned to the account for future scholarships. If a deferral for a Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints mission is needed (1-1/2 to 2 years) a letter should be sent to the Washington County School District Foundation office asking to hold the funds.

Submission (completed by student applicant): Student Application.

Deadline for submission: Must be received at the Hurricane High School counseling office before April 15th.
