Dear HHS Senior:

We invite you to apply for our annual Hurricane Valley Sons of the Utah Pioneers Scholarship. We have two scholarships available for one boy and one girl. The amount of the awards will depend on donations received by our chapter, but it is at least \$500 each.

Requirement 1: Read a story about one of your direct ancestors and write an essay highlighting that person's life. We want you to explain how your learning more about this ancestor has influenced you and your life. It should be typed and free of errors, and a minimum of one, but no more than three pages.

Requirement 2: have a cover page with your picture, name, address and telephone Number. (e-mail also if you have one) The name and relationship of the ancestor you chose to write about should also be included on this page, along with any citizenship/leadership at school, or around the community, that you have been involved with that might help us in judging.

Requirement 3: Attach an official high school transcript with the cover page and Essay.

Applicants will be judged on the following criteria:

- a. Essay, Content and Neatness
- b. Academic Achievement from transcript
- c. Citizenship: General attitudes and behaviors at school and in the community.

The deadline for applications and essays to be turned in is April 25th. They will be picked up in the Counseling Center. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.
